THE CHALLENGE

Lanidor, has been focusing on its brand internationalization, they intend to use a document management and workflow solution that allows its Administrator, and other employees, to ensure the continuity of work processes, invoices approval and document signing, anywhere in the world. They also wanted to acquired a solution with a good quality/price relation.

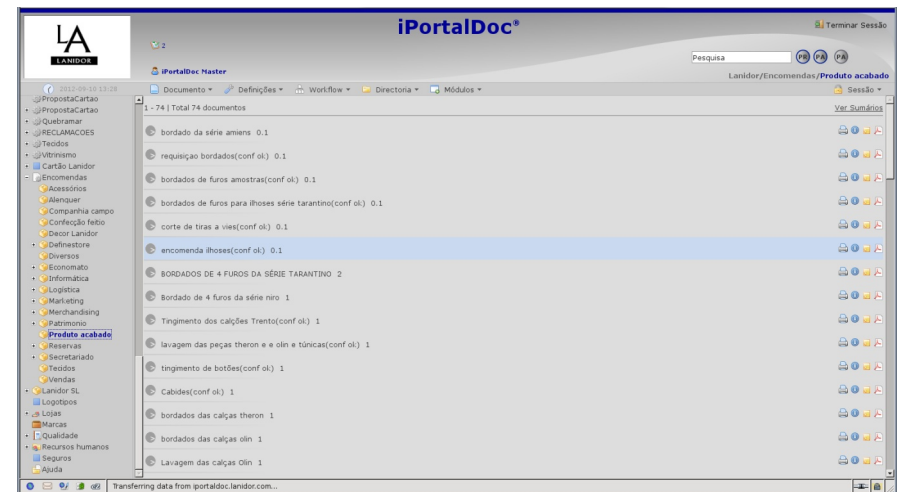
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Lanidor is using PDF templates for invoices and orders, which are scanned and forwarded to different departments following a workflow.
