# Enable IPBRICK OS License Through a file

Access IPBrick's web interface, **Advanced Configurations » IPBrick » WEB Access**  
In the bottom left corner, click on **“Download server identification for license generation”** to download the file that identifies

To enable the license, you must access to the menu: **Advanced Configurations » IPBrick » WEB Access**, upload the license file that was sent to you by email and click on Modify. (you can update this file whenever you wish since it doesn't interfere with the services)

## *Through Activation Code*

It is also possible to enable IPBRICK OS licenses through the usage of an activation code. If you own a license activation code for IPBRICK OS, you must insert it on ***Advanced Configurations » IPBrick » WEB Access***, and select the option ***Activation Code***.
